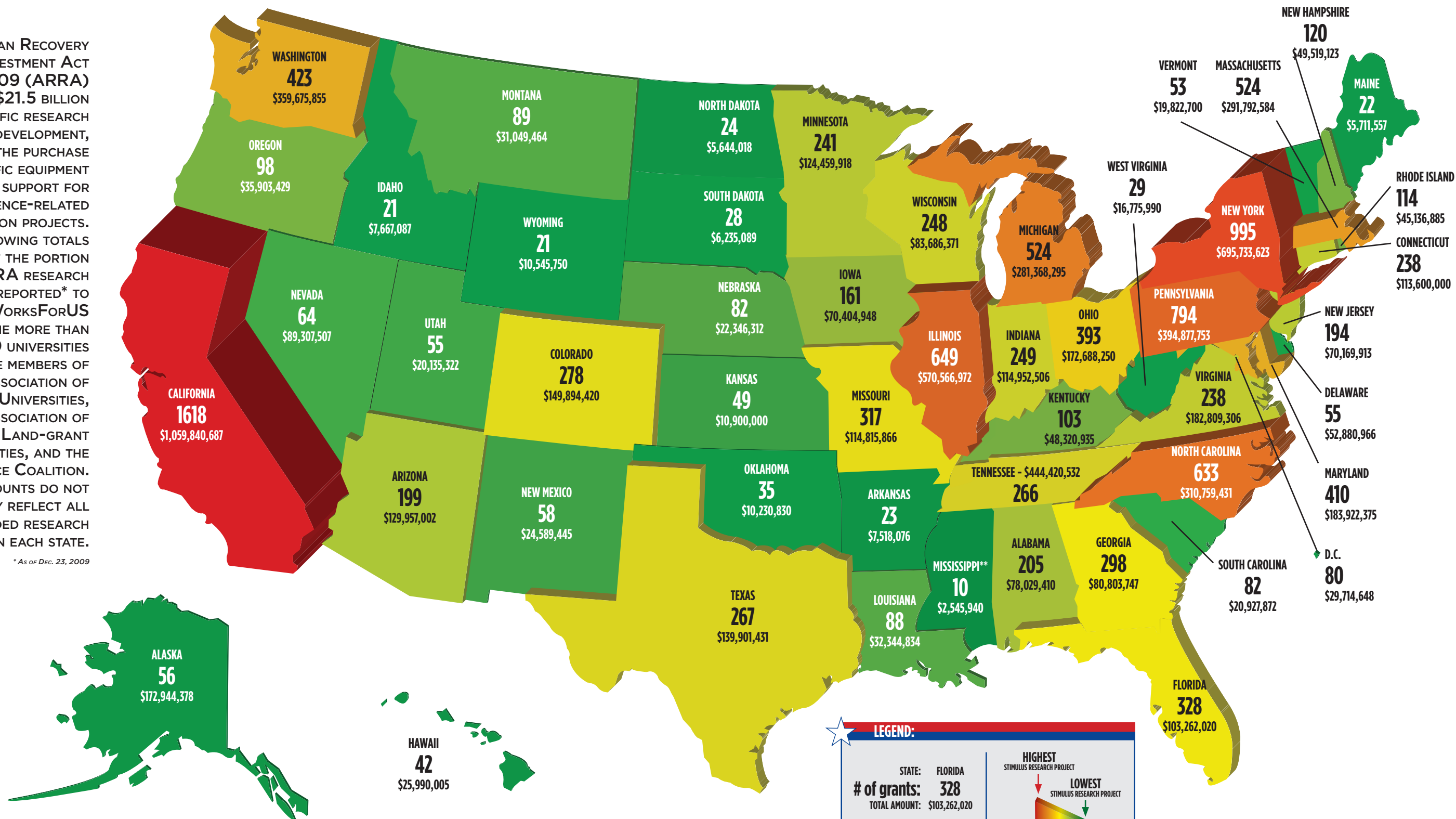


STIMULUS RESEARCH:

HOW STATES FARED

THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009 (ARRA) PROVIDED \$21.5 BILLION FOR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT, INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF SCIENTIFIC EQUIPMENT AND SUPPORT FOR SCIENCE-RELATED CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS. THE FOLLOWING TOTALS REPRESENT THE PORTION OF ARRA RESEARCH FUNDS REPORTED* TO SCIENCEWORKSFORUS BY THE MORE THAN 200 UNIVERSITIES THAT ARE MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION OF AMERICAN UNIVERSITIES, THE ASSOCIATION OF PUBLIC AND LAND-GRANT UNIVERSITIES, AND THE SCIENCE COALITION. AMOUNTS DO NOT NECESSARILY REFLECT ALL ARRA-FUNDED RESEARCH ACTIVITY IN EACH STATE.
