

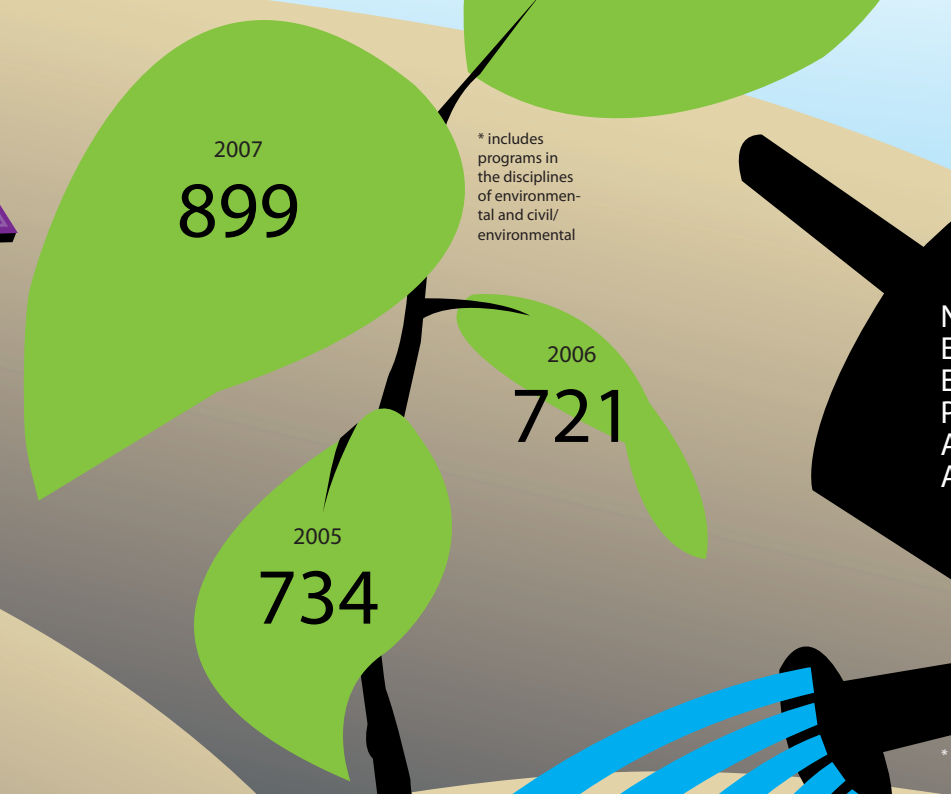

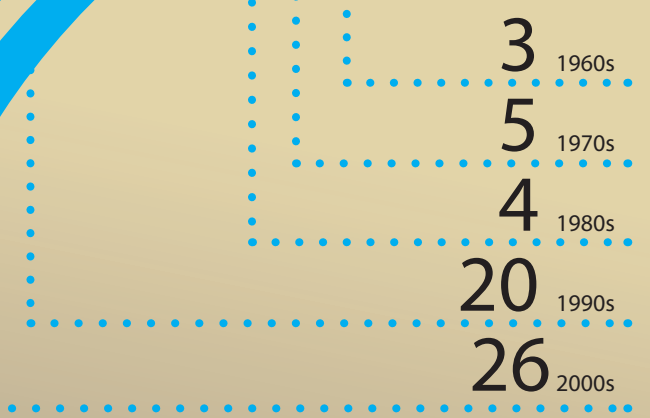
NUMBER OF BACHELOR'S DEGREES AWARDED IN ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING, 2005-2008\*



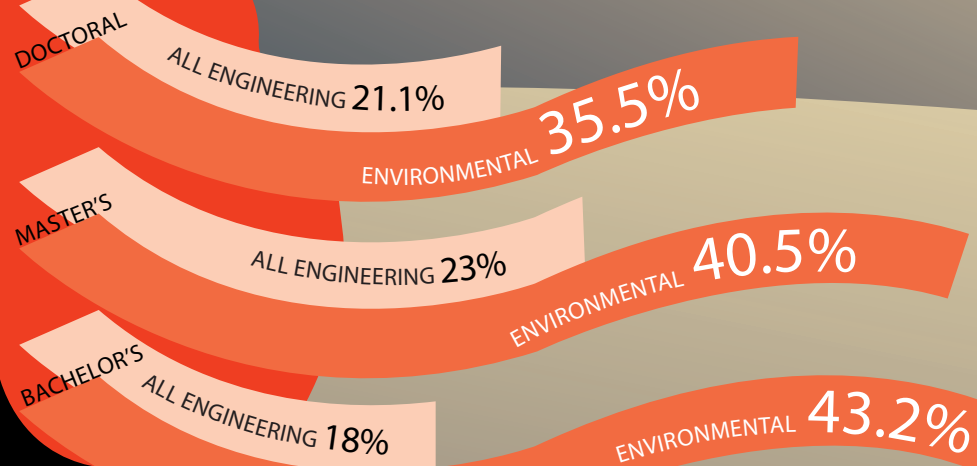
